

Terry Glover uses shower curtain liners to coral woodturning chips in his shop. Terry hates sweeping his shop after rough turning a large bowl blank. The wood chips fly everywhere, ending up in the strangest, hard to reach, areas of the shop. His solution is to hang shower curtains around the lathe to coral the wood chips.



*Normally the curtains are left drawn behind the lathe when turning small objects like pens and boxes.*



*When roughing a large bowl blank, the curtains are closed.*



*One end curtains is left open when doing final cuts for easy access to the grinder.*



*The curtains are hung from the ceiling using 1/4" all-thread rod and 3/4" Electrical metal Tubing (EMT)*
